

KEVIN EMERY :- Hampshire C.C.C..

Kevin made his debut for Hampshire in 1982 and claimed 83 wickets. He was the country's fourth highest wicket taker. He was selected for England B against Pakistan, awarded the Commercial Union 'Young Cricketer of the Year' prize and was voted the Hampshire Young Cricketer of the Year. He seemed to have the world at his feet.



Thereafter he suffered cricket's equivalent of the golfing 'yips'. Everything disintegrated in his run up, length, direction and purpose. It remains one of Hampshire cricket's greatest mysteries.

He was, of course, not the only bowler to suffer from this type of problem.

In his early years he represented Swindon schoolboys as a footballer and England Schools at cricket. He was also a British Universities cricketer and footballer.

After county cricket he played for Wiltshire and the MCC.
